Annual Archeparchial Women's Day

Saturday, March 28, 2009, the Ukrainian Catholic Archeparchy of Philadelphia will hold the annual Women's Day at the Immaculate Conception Cathedral Hall, 827 N. Franklin St. in Philadelphia. Kimberly Hashin, MD, will be the speaker. The topic is "From Grief to Grace." *This day will explore how to make sense of loss, grief and sadness and how to work through it. Loss shapes our lives and self-understanding and can lead to a defining experience where we can overcome the feelings of emptiness and work toward wholeness.*

Registration begins at 9:00 a.m. The program runs from 9:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Registration in advance is \$25, or \$30 at the door, and includes lunch and parking. *If you are interested in going, please contact the rectory. There will be a van leaving from our church.*

"Fight FOCA Postcard Campaign"

The Freedom of Choice Act (FOCA) is a radical piece of legislation that creates a "fundamental right" to abortion throughout the nine months of pregnancy. No governmental body at any level—federal, state, or local—would be able to "deny or interfere with" this right, or to "discriminate" against its exercise. For the first time, abortion would become an *entitlement* the government must fund and promote. A broad range of laws currently allowed under *Roe V. Wade* would be eliminated—*informed consent laws; parental involvement laws; laws prohibiting a particular abortion procedure (e.g., partial-birth abortion); laws requiring that abortions be performed by a licensed physician; and so on.*

The "Fight FOCA Postcard Campaign" sends the message to Congress that the radical policies of FOCA are out of step with the most basic values of the American people and should not become a part of our nation's laws in any way. Anyone can sign a postcard! Age does not matter and you do not have to be a registered voter. Everyone has the right to communicate with the elected officials who represent them.

Our parish, along with thousands of other parishes across the nation, will sign postcards urging Congress to oppose the "Freedom of Choice Act." The postcards come in sets of three. Sign a postcard to your local U.S. Representative and your two U.S. Senators. The Senators for New Jersey are Frank Lautenberg and Robert Menendez. Be sure to include your address so that you can receive a response.
