APRIL IS CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION MONTH**How Old Does a Child Need to Be in Order to Stay Alone?**

Don't assume that when your child understands what you're saying, he's ready to walk out the door by himself. Besides the fact that many states have laws against leaving children of certain ages alone (for example, younger than 12), experts say children shouldn't be left by themselves until they're capable of fighting off an abductor or handling a crisis situation. Experts also say children do not have the mental maturity to cross busy streets by themselves until they're about 10 or 12 years old. (Did you know that pedestrian injuries rank third in child fatalities, behind traffic accidents and drowning?) Finally, parents who are certain their young children would never walk away with a stranger will be shocked to learn that studies show they probably will. Stay alert and vigilant, even if you believe your child is aware of possible dangers from others.

СКІЛЬКИ РОКІВ ПОВИННА МАТИ ДИТИНА, ЩОБИ ЗАЛИШАТИСЯ САМОТНЬОЮ?

Не думайте, що коли ваша дитина розуміє що ви до неї говорите, вона готова йти і бути самою на вулиці. Хоча багато штатів прийняли закони щодо того, щоби не залишати дітей певного віку самотніми (наприклад, молодші ніж 12 років), експерти кажуть, що діти не повинні залишатися самі до того часу поки вони є здатними втекти від викрадача або поводитися правильно в критичній ситуації. Вони також стверджують, що діти не мають розумової зрілості перейти через вулицю самі, аж поки їм не сповниться 10 або 12 років. (Чи ви знаєте, що наїзд на пішоходів займає третє місце серед причин дитячої смертності після випадків на дорогах та утоплення?) Також, батьки, впевнені, що їхні діти ніколи не підуть слідом за незнайомцем, здивуються коли дізнаються, як дослідження показують, що діти таки підуть за незнайомцем. Будьте напоготові та пильні, навіть якщо ви вірите, що ваша дитина знає про всі небезпеки від інших.
