LENT BEGINS TOMORROW!

The Holy Great Fast, or Lent, the season of spiritual renewal and reconciliation of God and man, begins tomorrow - Monday, February 15.

Laws of Fasting for Lent:

The first day of Lent and Good Friday, all persons 14 years of age and over are obliged to abstain from meat and dairy products. On all Fridays of Lent and Holy Saturday, meat may not be eaten. Anyone who performs hard manual labor, the sick, pregnant and nursing mothers, are exempt.

Lenten Services:

Stations of the Cross: Tuesdays at 6:30 p.m.

Sorokousty, Liturgy and Lenten Commemoration of the Dead: Thursdays at 6:30 p.m.

Reconciliation:

Every Christian has an obligation in conscience to be reconciled with God by means of the Sacrament of Confession at least once a year at Easter time. This period starts with the beginning of Holy Lent and lasts until Ascension Thursday.

Calendar Correction: Stations of the Cross will be held on Tuesdays, not Wednesdays.

SHROUD OF TURIN EXHIBITION

Archbishop Stefan has procured an official replica of the Shroud of Turin for display at our Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Philadelphia. The 14'X 3' Shroud replica will be on exhibition at the Cathedral from February 21, 2010 - June 29th, 2010.

The Exhibit will begin with vespers at 5:00PM at the Cathedral on the First Sunday of the Great Fast, February 21, 2010. Clergy and parishioners are invited to join with us and to have representatives bring crosses, icons, or plaschanytsias from the parishes for this opening Procession for the Sunday of Orthodoxy.
