Sunday of Orthodoxy



Today is the Sunday of Orthodoxy. It commemorates the victory of the true teachings of the Lord over the iconoclastic heresy, which forbade the veneration of images of the Lord, His mother, or the saints. The true teaching, hence the word "orthodox," meaning "true doctrine," is that we use those icons to remind us of the Lord and the saints. Considering this Sunday's meaning, we may say it is time for us to paint an icon of the Lord in our hearts. It is a time to let His countenance shine in us.



GLOSSARY/TERMS

In this section, you will find an explanations of some terms and greetings that often used in our church.

- **"Slava Isusu Christu"** ("Glory to Jesus Christ") - Greeting used during the Pentecost season. The response to this greeting is "Slava na Veeky" which means "Glory for ever."
- **"Christos Razhdajetsja"** ("Christ is born!") - Greeting used during the Christmas season. The response to this greeting is "Slaveety Yoho" which means "Glorify Him!"
- **"Christos Voskres"** ("Christ has risen!") - Greeting used during the Easter season. The response to this greeting is "Voistynu Voskres" which means "Indeed he has risen!"
- **Iconostas** - A screen or grating that separates the sanctuary from the body of the church. The iconostas has three doors: the royal doors in the center which are used by the priest during some ceremonies; and two deacon's doors which are located on either side of the royal doors. Near the doors are icons of Jesus Christ, Mary, St. Nicholas and the patron saint of the church.
- **Koliady** - Christmas carols having a religious element.
- **Mnohaya Lita** - Literally means "Many Years". This is traditionally sung for special occasions to express best wishes.
- **Panakhya** - A short church service for the dead. It is used on Memorial Day, during a burial and on special occasions.
- **Paska** - The Easter bread that represents Jesus Christ. When the parishioners consume Paska, they are symbolically partaking in Christ's resurrection.
- **Plaschenyca** - A holy shroud with a picture of Christ in death. This shroud is venerated from Good Friday until Easter matins.
- **Pysanky** - Easter eggs that are intricately hand painted. This symbol dates back to pagan times in Ukraine when the painted egg represented the resurrection of nature to a new life at the beginning of springtime.
- **Sorokousty** - A Lenten service in which prayers of remembrance are offered for all Christians who have died through the years. This service also remembers those that we love who have died.
- **Tetrapod** - Little table that stands before the iconostas. A cross, candles and an icon are typically placed on the tetrapod..
- **Velykden** - Term used to denote Easter..
- **Zeleni Sviata** - Literally means "Green Holyday". This refers to the Holyday of Pentecost which occurs 50 days after Easter and commemorates the "visible descent of the Holy Spirit" upon the Apostles.



I know I am speaking to quite a number of people today. You have made a commitment to Christ as your savior – but nearly every day, you find that you are feeling lonely – and seemingly lonelier as each day passes. Let me give you some practical pointers for overcoming your loneliness.

First, you need to quit dwelling on your loneliness. Instead, reach out and try to help someone else who is lonely. Luke 6:38 promises us that when we give, it shall be given to us. There is a locked-in likeness to what we give. It is the law of the harvest. Proverbs 18:24 tells us that if you want friendship, you must show yourself friendly.

Take this concept and make it become reality in your life. You can easily begin with doing this. Keep a stack of cards and a pen handy, and write little notes of encouragement to others. Get a prayer list and intercede for others. You can travel around the world by means of prayer.

No life is as empty as a self-centered life. And there is no life so Christ-centered as a self-emptied life. As you pour out yourself to others, the Holy Spirit will continually pour Himself into you.

Let me challenge you to do at least one of these things each day:

- 1. Write someone an encouraging email or a letter.
- 2. Do something good for one of your contacts or co-workers.
- 3. Pray for five people who are lost that God would save them.
- 4. Go on a prayer walk around your neighborhood, or a prayer drive around your town, and pray that the people there would get saved.
- 5. Call a new friend and ask how you can pray for him or her.
- 6. Share a meal with a stranger and share the Gospel.
- 7. Bless a servant of God with your grateful greetings.
- Do this whole-heartedly, and I will guarantee you that your loneliness will quickly disappear!

Who was Taras Shevchenko ?



How many English-speaking people have heard of Taras Shevchenko. What "Uncle Tom's Cabin" did for the African Americans of the United States of America the poems of Shevchenko did for the serfs of Ukraine. They aroused the conscience of the Ukrainian people, and the persecutions suffered by the poet at the hands of the auto-cracy awakened their sympathy. It was two days after the death of Shevchenko that the czar's ukase appeared granting freedom to the serfs. Possibly the dying poet knew it was coming and died the happier on that account. Shevchenko was a Ukrainian poet, artist and humanist. His literary heritage is regarded to be the foundation of modern Ukrainian literature and, to a large extent, the modern Ukrainian language. Shevchenko's poetry contributed greatly to the growth of Ukrainian national consciousness, and his influence on various facets of Ukrainian intellectual, literary, and national life is still felt to this day
